Residents' Parking Schemes

The Council has been out to consultation with residents about new Parking Schemes in Wollaton Park and Lenton Abbey. The consultation period has now closed and the plans are being finalised in the light of comments made.

AJ Sports

For some years AJ Sports have been providing high quality sports activities for children and young people in the ward, particularly at Lenton Abbey Park. Sally met with them recently to discuss possible ways to enhance the facilities at the Park. She has raised these issues with Dave Trimble the Portfolio Holder responsible, and with the Parks team and hopefully we can find a way of supporting AJ's ambitions for the future.

New Student Residents

Our Wollaton Park CPO David Fowkes has been knocking on doors of student households in the area, introducing himself and explaining about waste management and other issues, we hope this will help community cohesion.

Lenton Lodge

Residents have raised concerns with us about the frontage of Lenton Lodge, on Derby Road. The University took over the building some time ago and since then there has been parking on the frontage which we feel detracts from the beauty of the building. We have been asking them to take action to improve the situation for some time, and the City Council Planning Department have been working with them to develop plans. We now we believe progress is being made and hope to be able to share their ideas soon.

Good Garden Awards

We held two Good Garden Awards Tea Parties in Lenton Abbey and Wollaton Park. We thoroughly enjoyed the opportunity to thank the residents who go the extra mile in keeping their front garden looking nice for all to enjoy. We were also glad to announce that the gardeners of Wollaton Park Residents' Association had been awarded a Britain In Bloom Outstanding Award, for their work in Farndon Green. The display has been magnificent this year and there has been a great deal of effort to keep everything watered in the hot summer.

Keep Warm This Winter

Although fuel poverty figures for the ward have improved a lot since the solid wall insulation projects were completed a few years ago, we know there will still be residents who are worried about paying their bills and keeping warm. If you know of anyone who is Over 60 and lives in a draughty home and you feel is at risk this winter please get in touch. They may be eligible for a free home Energy Check from Age UK, who can provide advice and some practical solutions to reduce their problems.

Abbey Lodge

For several years we have been working to support residents of Abbey Lodge. This month we organised a very well attended meeting at the Sheila Roper Centre, for residents to meet with the new Area Director of Stonewater and Nottingham City Council Housing Strategy. A follow up meeting will be taking place in a few weeks time, when hopefully some of the outstanding issues will be resolved.
