

### Community Statistics 2017-18

Community Statistics relate to all incidents that occur outside of NTU/UPP run accommodation. This includes local areas, the city centre, and on campus.

In the academic year so far, there have been 148 reported incidents in the community; of which 60 are noise complaints. This equates to around **40%** of cases.

The breakdown of the total cases, per area and incident type, is shown below:

We received 33 incident reports from the Arboretum area in the academic year 2017-18, compared to 14 in the academic year 2016-17. Of these 33 cases, 25 were regarding noise issues (76%). In 2016-17, 100% of reported cases were regarding noise issues.
